### **Information about the police monitoring committee.**

The police monitoring committee receives tips, complaints and charges regarding police operations.

Those who believe an employee of the police has (1) committed a punishable offence at work, (2) practised reprehensible methods or conduct at work, or (3) are unhappy with the general operation methods of the police, can contact the committee directly with a notification and ask for a review for their case.

### **Instructions**

It is important to include the following information in the notification to the committee:

- Full name, home address, phone number and the identification number of the person who submits the notification.
- A description of the conduct or incident which is reported.  
Here, a short description of the conduct or incident which is reported must be included. The office and/or employee which the report concerns may be detailed if the information is available.
- Date and signature of the person which submits the report.
- If available, documents or data which might give insight into the circumstances of the case may be submitted with the report.
